Integrated Learning Training Platform

Integrated Learning is a **training platform built directly in Dragon Medical One**. This provides a myriad of short training videos, resource guides, on-demand webinars, and other training materials.

There are three ways to access:

- 1. With Dragon Medical One open, dictate the voice command, **"Open training."**
- Tap the ■ on the DragonBar, navigate to What You Can Say. On the What You Can Say menu, tap the ■, then tap Training.
